## **Local Transportation**

Site is accessed directly from the A34, 2.5 miles south of Alderley Edge using the Church Lodge entrance. See map on next page. Visitor parking is available on site.

Alderley Edge Station – is a 5 minute taxi ride, prebooked taxi recommended.

Macclesfield station – is a 20 minute taxi ride, has taxi rank, pre-booking not essential.

Manchester Airport – is a 20-30 minute taxi ride, has airport taxi rank.

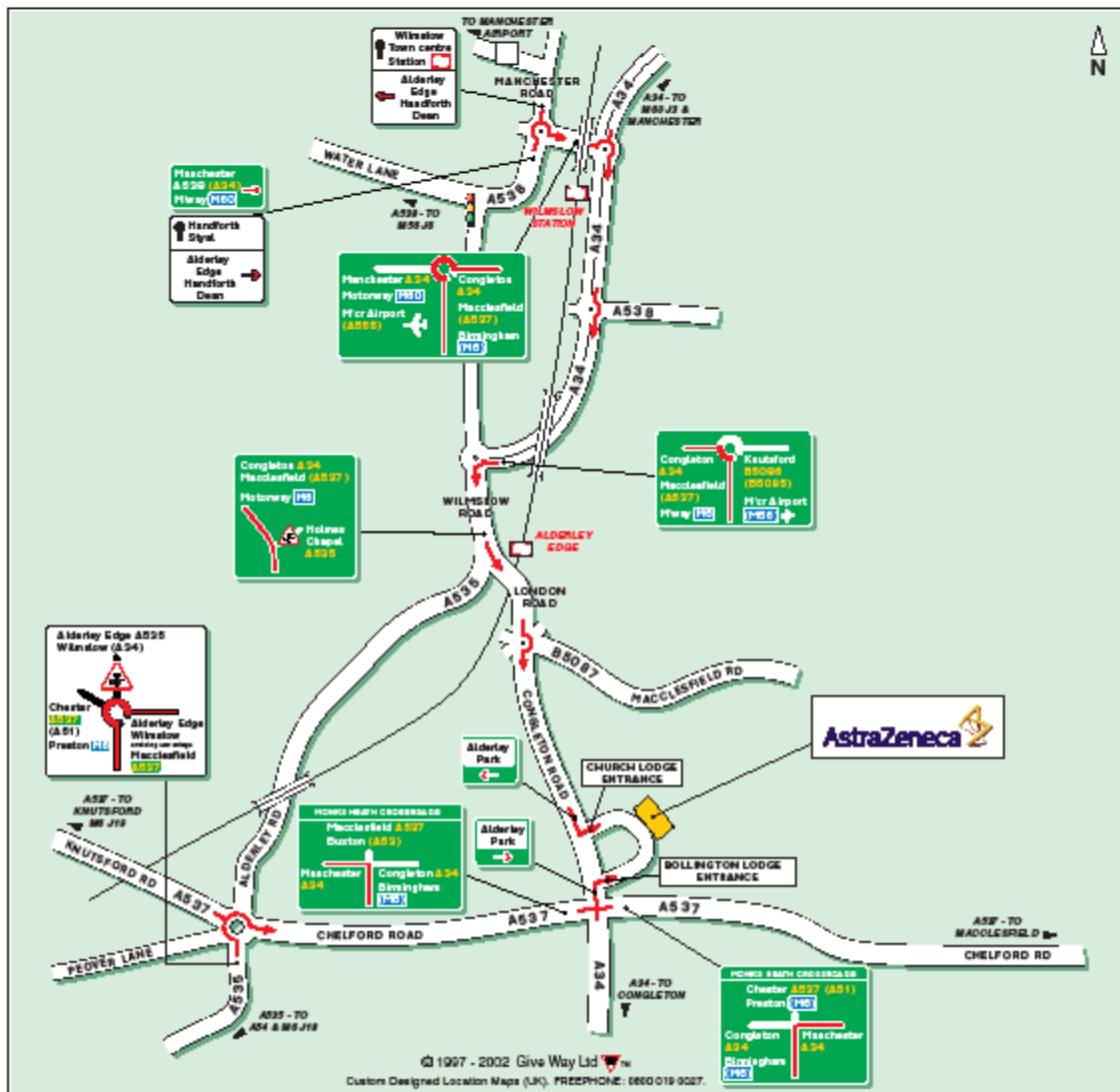
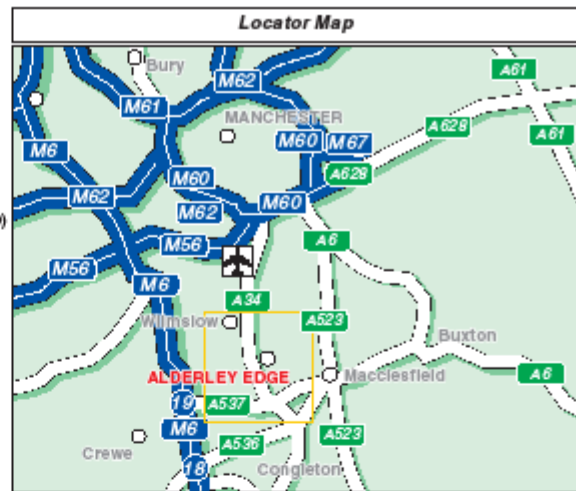
